

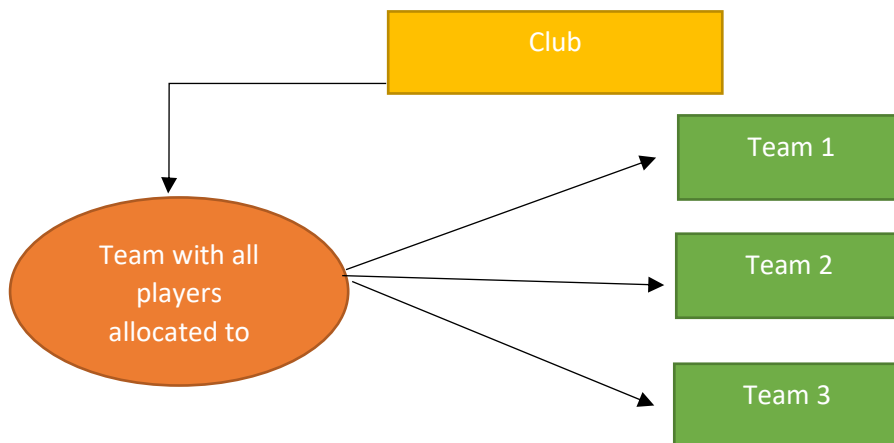
G6/G7 2023 Competition Update

The G6/G7 competition has continued to grow year on year, with 222 registered player's last season. This was an increase of 60 players. The flexible competition format has allowed the competition to thrive as it has created an inclusive environment with Female players from all clubs provided the opportunity to participate in the competition. See breakdown of player numbers below:

With the increase in player numbers, we believe that a more structured competition draw will help with the organisation on the ground. We also still want to retain the flexibility within the age group so that we aren't putting up barriers to player participation. For season 2023, clubs will be required to nominate teams to be included in the draw. The teams won't consist of any players, they are simply shell teams that will be used for the draw. Clubs are encouraged to shuffle players around the teams, depending on the number of players available on the day and the ability of the players.

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G6/G7 Roles and Responsibilities

G6/G7 Club Champions Role & Responsibility

- Point of contact for parents communicating and leading the aim of the program
- Commitment to arrive 8:40am each Sunday as point of contact
- Lead creating an inclusive culture with club players as well as players, parents, and champions from other clubs
- Ensure all players attend with a ball or the coach brings footballs so players can start with ball mastery
- Ensure players get to the right field on time
- Using Inspire and with on ground support club champions to deliver ball mastery on the field they will be playing on
- Roster parents, siblings, or club youth players to facilitate ('game lead') the matches
- Manage parent behaviour to ensure we are creating the inclusive and empowering environment
- Have a flexible approach rotating players in teams if club has more players for one team
- Have a flexible approach to ensure players are in appropriate football environment. Change players if games are significantly one sided
- Be flexible with formats 2v2, 3v3, to support players having fun and playing
- Be leaders in creating an inclusive and empowering environment centred on the girls developing a deep love of the game
- On hand to facilitate with games
- Have fun

Program Leader Role & Responsibilities

- Wear NSFA/NT/XLR8 Gear, watch, whistle and have a foghorn (NSFA to supply foghorn)
- Arrive (45minutes prior to KO) 8.15am for 9am KO
- Set up fields by 8.45am using pop up goals and cones from storeroom
- Greet players when they arrive – smiles, lots of energy
- Support club champions finding the correct fields
- Support club champions running ball mastery on the field they are due to play on
- Engage with individual players in ball mastery teaching ball manipulation
- Use the foghorn to signal start of games
- Work with the Club Champions to facilitate smooth running of games to ensure positive experience by all. When necessary rotate players, teams to ensure games are positive experience for all.
- Time Management to ensure the games run on time
- Pack away all gear and ensure store shed is locked (if applicable)
